Нагадуємо, що у конкурсі можуть брати участь особи віком до 45 років з дворічним професійним досвідом: викладачі; аспіранти та дослідники, які ще не мають наукового ступеня; кандидати наук; адміністратори вищих навчальних закладів; співробітники науково-дослідних установ; журналісти; фахівці з бібліотечної, музейної та архівної справи; спеціалісти у сфері управління культурою; працівники громадських організацій.

До участі у конкурсі приймаються лише індивідуальні проєкти — дослідницькі та такі,

що спрямовані на розробку та запровадження нових навчальних курсів, оновлення навчальних матеріалів, вивчення та оволодіння передовими методами навчання та викладання.

У 2024 році Офіс Інституту міжнародної освіти в Києві приймає документи на фулбрайтівські програми не тільки від конкурсантів, які проживають в Україні, але й від тих громадян України, які через війну змушені були покинути країну після 24 лютого 2022 року.

На стипендіатів Фулбрайта, військовозобов'язаних чоловіків, поширюються обмеження в перетині кордону на виїзд з України на період правового режиму воєнного стану.

Документи на конкурс можна подати до 1 листопада 2024 року.

Про програму імені Фулбрайта в Україні

Програма імені Фулбрайта, спонсорована урядом США, посідає чільне місце у системі міжнародної освіти. Узасаднена ідеєю взаємодії та взаєморозуміння й уґрунтована на пізнанні та повазі до розмаїтого світу, вона успішно діє з 1946 року, нині — у 155 країнах світу. За час існування Програми в Україні - з 1992 року — близько 1000 українців навчалися, стажувалися, проводили дослідження у США; понад 650 американців викладали в українських вищих навчальних закладах і займались науковою працею.

Fulbright Graduate Student Program: Навчання в американських університетах від одного до двох років на здобуття ступеня магістра. У конкурсі можуть брати участь студенти старших курсів та випускники ВНЗ. Кандидати повинні мати щонайменше диплом бакалавра на час призначення стипендії.

Кінцевий термін подання заявок – 16 травня щороку

Fulbright Foreign Language Teaching Assistant: Стажування з викладання української мови (асистенція американським викладачам) в університетах/коледжах США. У конкурсі можуть брати участь викладачі-початківці та молоді фахівці, які спеціалізуються з лінгвістики, української літератури, перекладацьких студій, комунікацій, журналістики, американських студій, викладання англійської мови. Кандидати повинні мати щонайменше диплом бакалавра на час призначення стипендії.

# Кінцевий термін подання заявок – 1 червня щороку

**Fulbright Scholar Program:** Проведення досліджень в університетах США, дослідницьких центрах, бібліотеках, музеях, архівах тощо тривалістю від трьох до дев'яти місяців. У конкурсі можуть брати участь кандидати та доктори наук; діячі культури, фахівці з бібліотекарства, журналісти та юристи; дослідники без наукового ступеня з досвідом роботи не менше п'яти років; аспіранти та здобувачі напередодні захисту.

Кінцевий термін подання заявок – 15 жовтня щороку

Fulbright Research and Development Program: Проведення досліджень в університетах США тривалістю від шести до дев'яти місяців. У конкурсі можуть брати участь особи віком до 40 років з дворічним професійним досвідом: викладачі; аспіранти та дослідники, які ще не мають наукового ступеня; кандидати наук (не пізніше 5-ти років після захисту); адміністратори вищих навчальних закладів; співробітники науководослідних установ; журналісти; фахівці з бібліотечної, музейної та архівної справи; спеціалісти у сфері управління культурою; працівники громадських організацій (НДО).

Кінцевий термін подання заявок – 1 листопада щороку

**U.S. Fulbright Scholar Program**: Запрошення американських науковців й фахівців для викладання й проведення дослідження на термін від одного семестру до двох.

Кінцевий термін подання заявок – 31 жовтня щороку

Fulbright Specialist Program: Запрошення фахівців на термін від двох до шести тижнів для читання лекцій; участі в наукових програмах й конференціях; консультування керівників й адміністраторів з питань управління освітою; проведення семінарів, спрямованих на підвищення кваліфікації українських спеціалістів; осучаснення навчальних програм й оновлення навчальних матеріалів; започаткування спільних наукових проектів і програм обмінів.

Термін подання заявок — за три-чотири місяці до планованої дати прибуття фахівця

# **Key Elements of a Competitive Application**

### Application:

- Take care to answer all questions to the best of your ability.
- Make sure that you spell your name correctly and in English; do not use diacritical markings, if you only have one name, use the last name field.
- Make sure that the information you have added into the online application text boxes displays completely.
- When prompted:
  - List all post-secondary schools attended, including study abroad programs, and list in order of those most recently attended.
  - List all academic, professional, and personal awards and honors achieved.
  - Write a clearly articulated study objective or academic goal statement. This is an important component of your application and is your opportunity to state what you want to study and to achieve. Be specific.
  - Write a personal statement that clearly details who you are and your experiences. You can both highlight your strengths and address any inconsistencies or perceived weaknesses.
  - Review the plagiarism agreement and acknowledge that you understand and will comply with the agreement.
  - Upload your resume or a CV (Curriculum vitae).
  - Upload copies of your student transcripts (*Please note, official transcripts prepared by the schools you attended will still be needed*).
  - For programs that utilize IIE placement services, indicate up to 8 university programs in order of preference and share any other pertinent information that someone handling your placement should know if you are selected.

### **Letters of Reference:**

- IMPORTANT! Letters of References should ideally be from people who know you well in a professional capacity.
- IIE recommends focusing on work contacts OR on academic contacts. Depending on what is weighed more significantly by the admissions committee—your work experience or your academic background. This will vary by your field of study.
- Referees should be able to speak to your strengths.
- Referees should be chosen so that they say different things about you.
- Note, in some educational systems the reputation of the referee is important. However, in the U.S. this is not a consideration if the referee does not know you well.
- We recommend that your referees complete the online reference letter. You may register them as part of the online application process. However, if they cannot complete the online reference letter, all supplemental forms, including the letters of reference are accessible at <a href="https://apply.iie.org/portal/ffsp?tab=resources">https://apply.iie.org/portal/ffsp?tab=resources</a>.

# **Academic Transcripts and Translations** (sometimes referred to as mark sheets or degree statements):

- Transcripts must list all courses and/or subjects taken and the grades received. Ideally, they should indicate when the course was taken. Most transcripts contain a 'legend' that will explain what an 'excellent' grade, a 'passing' grade, etc. is. (*Please note a description of the course is NOT required*).
- You must submit official transcripts. In other words, they must be certified by the school, e.g. the Registrar's Office or Controller of Examinations (Official transcripts may NOT be certified by a professor or other legal authority) and be forwarded in an envelope that has not been opened by you, the student.
- Transcripts should be in the official language of the country unless the school provides an official transcript in English.
- If a translation is necessary, it can be issued by the school or by a qualified translator. Translations must be literal—not interpretive.
- Note, for those individuals studying in Europe and completing a Bologna-compliant degree, a diploma supplement in English is also needed.

## **Test Scores**

- IIE requires official test scores to be sent from the testing institution. An 'examinee' copy may be used while awaiting "official" scores, but eventually, universities will need "official" test scores.
- When taking the test, please make sure to indicate IIE as a test recipient.
- For TOEFLs and all GREs, the code is 2326.
- For GMAT exams, the code is F0F-4J-28
- For IELTS, select Institute of International Education from the 'Professional Bodies' listing.
- Note: TOEFL and IELTS scores are valid for two years. GRE and GMAT scores are valid for five years.
