## THE PARTIES

have concluded the present cooperation agreement, with which negotiated the following:

## OBJECTIVE OF THE MoU

1. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) essentially sets out general nature of the collaborative agreement between **Kırklareli University** and **V. I. Vernadsky Taurida National University**. It is not intended that the agreement shall give rise to any legal rights nor obligations between the two Universities.

The main objective of the present MoU is to create condition for students and lecturers of both Universities for developing international relations, scientific and cultural contacts through a mutually beneficial cooperation in the following fields:

- 1.1. Exchange of students and lecturers;
- 1.2. Joint development of scientific activities;
- 1.3. Exchange of information in the field of higher education and research.

## SCOPE OF THE MoU

1. Both Universities agreed to create conditions for cooperation in carrying out the following activities:
  - 1.1. Exchange of students, post-graduate students, lecturers and employees;
  - 1.2. Creation of joint teams for participation in international research activities;
  - 1.3. Exchange of scientific and technical information, reference data, publications, and academic information and literature;
  - 1.4. Joint participation in scientific conferences and symposiums;
  - 1.5. Other activities by mutual consent.



Except for those provisions set forth explicitly in this document, any conditions related to implementing the activities referred to in this Memorandum will be negotiated by both institutions and the concerned parties and agreed to in a written document in advance of commencing the activities.

## LIABILITIES AND FINANCIAL TERMS

1. In order to finance the joint activity, both parties agree to abide by the following principles:
  - 1.1. Each institution shall help to arrange local accommodation for visiting students;
  - 1.2. Each participating student or his/her institution shall be solely responsible for travel arrangements and the costs thereof. The additional charges, as passport, visas, telephone services, books and any other kind of personal taxes will also be supported by the student;
  - 1.3. Neither party shall assume any financial obligations arising from the MoU;
  - 1.4. The realization of bilateral scientific and research activities is on the basis of separate agreement in which the parties negotiate the financial terms and conditions in a written form.
  - 1.5. Each University can help its students by providing specific scholarships, and each institution will require participating students to maintain their own medical/health insurance to provide coverage while participating in a student exchange and all students shall be required to provide evidence of such insurance to the host institution.

## PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION


1. The liabilities determined under the scope of this MoU will be executed by the Parties of the agreement.
2. In a month's term after signing the present MoU each one of the parties names a coordinator of the joint activities and informs about that the other party in a written form.

## OTHER RELATED ARTICLES

1. Both Parties shall not transfer or assign all or any of their rights, obligations, interests or benefits to any third party.
2. The matters not included in the MoU will be resolved primarily according to the relevant legislation. In the case of absence of such legislation, the matters will be resolved with the principles of good faith, mutual understanding and reconciliation.
3. This Memorandum will come into force on the date that the governing bodies of both Parties give their formal approval and will remain in effect for a period of 5 (five) years after which it may be renewed.
4. Either party may terminate this Memorandum by officially notifying the other party of its intent to do so in writing by registered post six (6) months in advance.
5. The provisions of this Memorandum may be amended at any time by the mutual consent in writing of both Parties.
6. The present MoU has been made in 2 equal copies. This MoU is signed between the Parties on 05.08.2024.
